According to a report released by the regulator last year, Umeme noted that the current monthly service charges set by Electricity Regulatory Authority may not be reflective of the macroeconomic conditions in the country today. <u>Story</u>

<u>State House Anti-corruption Unit arrests 20 over fraud;</u> at least 20 public servants at Nansana Municipality in Wakiso District were on Friday arrested on charges of fraud connected to alleged misappropriation more than Shs2 billion, pending investigations into alleged mismanagement of income generated from property rates. <u>Story</u>

Museveni regrets Bujagali financing mechanism; whereas power from other dams and sources on the national grid go for 5 cents per unit, the one from Bujagali, according to Museveni goes for ¢8.7 per unit. Bujagali is a 250MW dam on River Nile, near Jinja commissioned by Museveni in 2012 at an estimated cost of \$800m. But for the last three years, the government has explored available opportunities, especially the World Bank, to refinance Bujagali with the aim of making power tariffs affordable. Story

Kobe Byrant died with his thirteen-year-old daughter in the helicopter crash; Kobe Bryant's 13-year-old daughter Gianna was among the fatalities in the helicopter crash which claimed the life of the NBA icon. Bryant died Sunday when the helicopter he was riding in crashed and burst into flames in thick fog, killing all nine people on board, and plunging the sports world into mourning. Story
